KERC (Procurement of Energy from Renewable Sources) (Third Amendment) Regulations, 2015

## Preamble

The Commission had published the draft of the Regulations to further amend KERC (Procurement of Energy from Renewable Sources)Regulations, 2011 [called as Principal Regulations], inviting comments, views and suggestions from the stakeholders as required under subsection (3) of Section 181 of the Electricity Act, 2003. The Commission also held a public hearing in the matter on 09.09.2015. After considering the views/comments/suggestions of the Stakeholders in the matter, the Commission, in exercise of the powers conferred under clause (e) of sub-section (1) of Section 86 read with Section 181 of the Electricity Act, 2003 (Central Act 36 of 2003) and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, hereby, makes the Regulations,

- 1. Short Title, application and commencement. -(i) These Regulations shall be called the Karnataka Electricity Regulatory Commission (Procurement of Energy from Renewable Sources) (Third Amendment) Regulations, 2015. (ii) These Regulations shall extend to the whole of the State of Karnataka. (iii)These Regulations shall come into force from the date of their publication in the official gazette.
- 2. In the existing Regulations, for the clause numbers indicated in columns(1), the Regulation as existing at column (2) of the Table below shall be replaced by the Regulation as indicated in column(3):
