AGE LIMIT: For Non-sponsored candidates, the age limit is 27 years as on 8/12/2014. No age limit for the sponsored candidates.

FEES: For non-sponsored & sponsored candidates, ₹1,50,000/- & ₹2,00,000/- respectively, excluding the lodging & boarding charges.

TOTAL SEATS: 60 (sixty seats - provisional).

PLACEMENT: Though CBIP is not committed for any confirmed placement, more than 54% students of current batch (5th batch completing in Mid November, 2014) have already been placed and process is still on.
