AGE LIMIT: For Non-sponsored candidates, the age limit is 27 years as on 21.04.2014. No age limit for the sponsored candidates.

FEES: For non-sponsored & sponsored candidates, ₹1,30,000/- & ₹1,50,000/- respectively, excluding the lodging & boarding charges.

TOTAL SEATS: 60 (sixty seats - provisional).

PLACEMENT: Though CBIP is not committed for any confirmed placement, the students of such previous completed batches have been placed in various companies through CBIP's linkages and the efforts of students themselves.
