












The Global Symposium 2014 will focus on the key initiatives required to transform from Knowledge to Competencies



Certification based on Exam is the basic step. It should lead to competency based certifications.



It is well understood globally today that Exam based project management certification reflects only the knowledge component and not the competencies required in managing projects. Exam based certification is like getting a Drivers License. Competency assessment in driving on highways or in complex traffic conditions requires a more rigorous process.
