Susanne Dorasil is the Head of the Economic Cooperation and Development Division at the Embassy of the Federal Republic of Germany in New Delhi.

She was formerly head of the division for Sustainable Economic Policy and Financial Sector at the German Federal Ministry of Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ). Until recently, Susanne Dorasil served as German co-facilitator of the G20 development pillar on Private Investment and Job Creation and as German co-chair of the sub-group on SME Finance of the G20 Global Partnership for Financial Inclusion.

She was also a member of the Social Impact Investment Task Force established under the UK G8 Presidency. Susanne Dorasil was Deputy Head of the Central Africa, West Africa II, Madagascar Division; Senior Advisor to the German Executive Director at the World Bank Group; Private Secretary to the Permanent State Secretary of the BMZ; and Deputy Head of the Legal Division.

She studied law at the Free University of Berlin and holds a Master of Laws degree from King's College London. She passed her bar examination in Berlin.
